Project GO, Inc. Community Action Agency (PGI) will convene a Community Forum to hear input on the needs of the poor in Placer County on Monday, January 7, 2019 from 1:30 pm - 3:30 pm at Placer Business Resource Center, 1000 Sunset Blvd., Suite 105 Rocklin, CA 95677. Interested Placer County residents, including representatives of community organizations, are invited to participate and share their views regarding the needs of very low-income populations of all ages. The information gathered at this Forum will contribute to the needs assessment process required as a part of the 2020/21 Community Action Plan (CAP). The CAP is part of the application process for ongoing Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funding.

Comments may be directed to the broad issues of poverty, unemployment, educational attainment, health, nutrition, housing conditions, homelessness, crime rates, incidents of delinquency, obstacles and problems that block the achievement of self-sufficiency (family and individual), and economic opportunity. More generally, PGI would like to hear ideas about services or programs that assist low-income populations in achieving self-sufficiency. Supporting data is encouraged.

Those who wish to speak at the Forum will be allowed 5 minutes to make his/her presentation. A sign-up sheet for speakers will be provided at the door. PGI has requested that all who testify also provide written testimony at this meeting.
